Linux x64 support

Both the Manager and Node now support x64 Linux.
This is quite important as x64 Linux can not execute x86 binaries.

Changed file naming.

As a preparation to localized versions of GoToDevice the filenames of the install files has been changed.

Possibility of OEM specific license keys.

An OEM ID field in the license makes it possible to lock licenses to a certain OEM vendor. A Node with a certain OEM ID is only able to receive connections from an Manager with the same OEM ID.

Possibility of Client specific license keys.

A Client ID field in the license makes it possible to lock licenses to a certain Client. A Node with a certain Client ID is only able to receive connections from a Manager with the same Client ID.



Possibility of limited functionality license keys.

A feature field in the license makes it possible to generate license keys which will limit the functionality of a Node. Eg. Only make the “Desktop” resource available.

Send Ctrl+Alt+Del in View drop-down menu.

Due to an error this menu disappeared in the previous build. Now it is back in place
